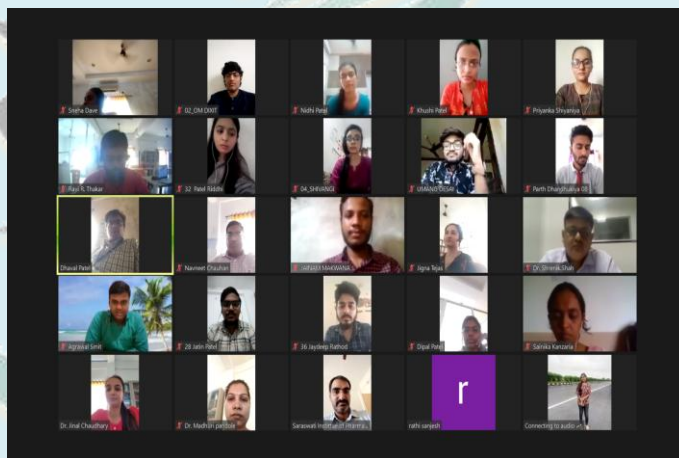
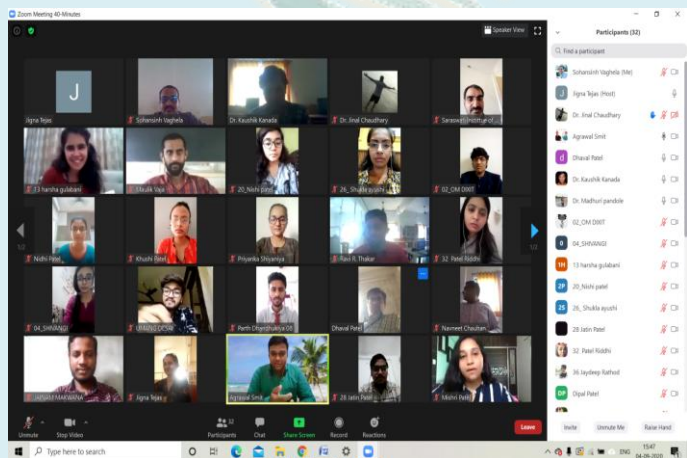

In Pharma film Students prepared Short film related to Theme.

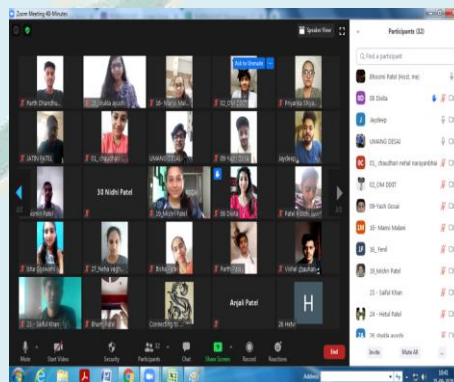
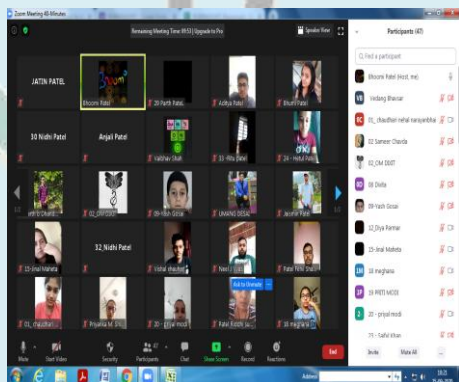

Day 1: INAUGURAL CEREMONY:

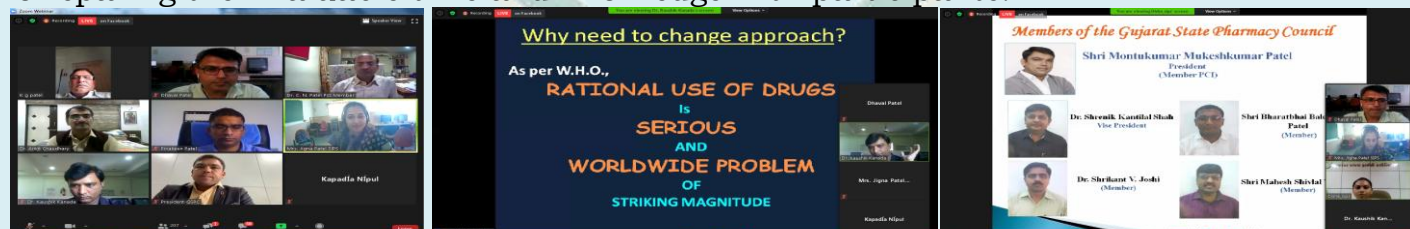

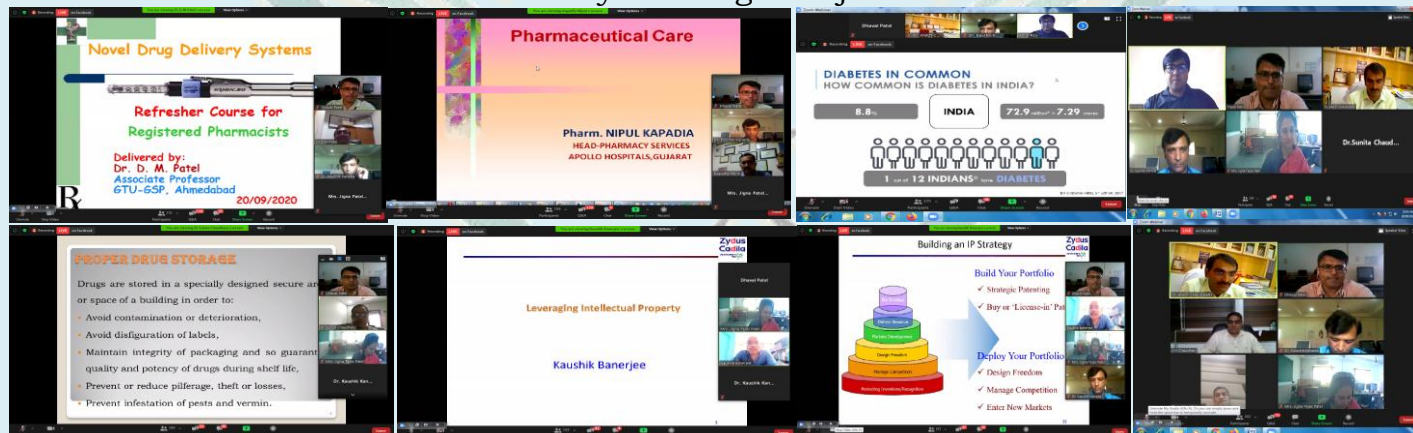
Dr. Dhaval J. Patel, Professor had given overview of Two days online Refresher course. Various participants had shared their feedback with other participants and guests regarding this event.

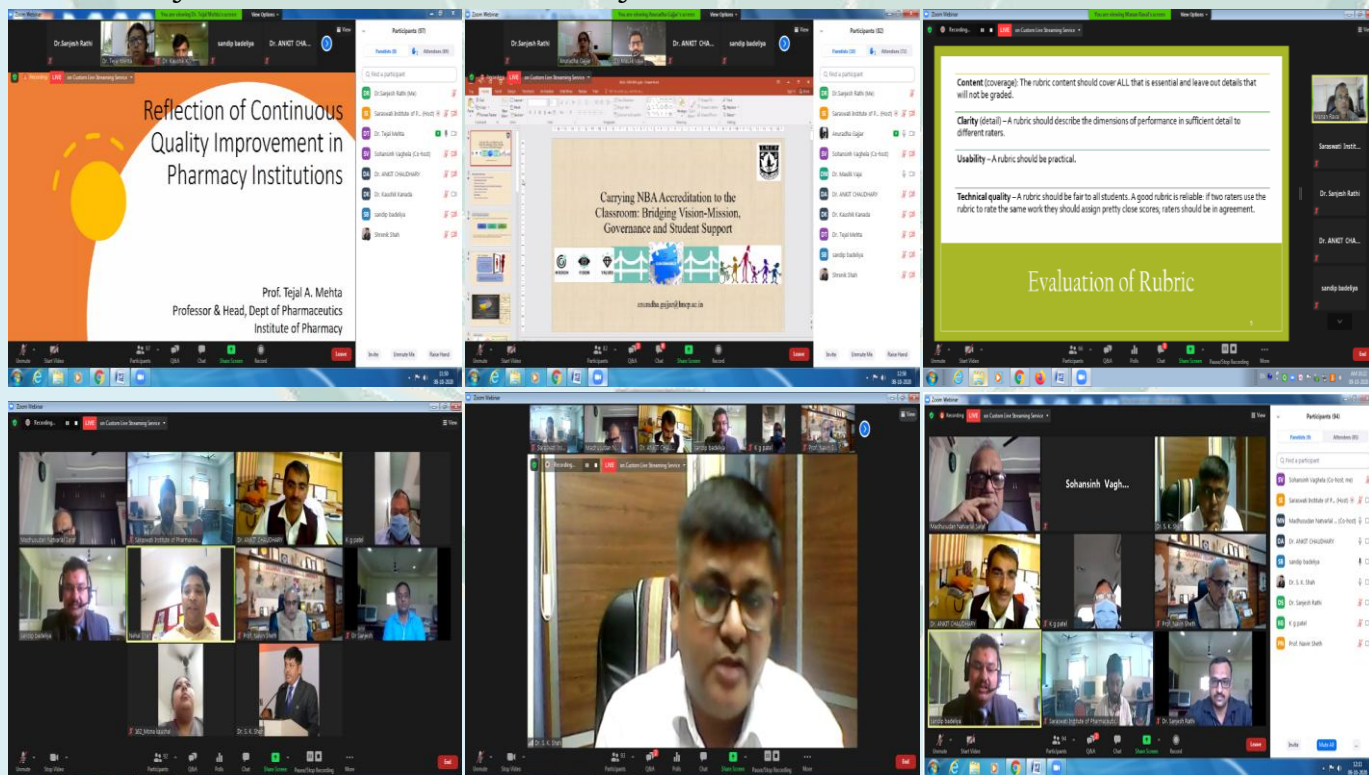

National Level vSTTP

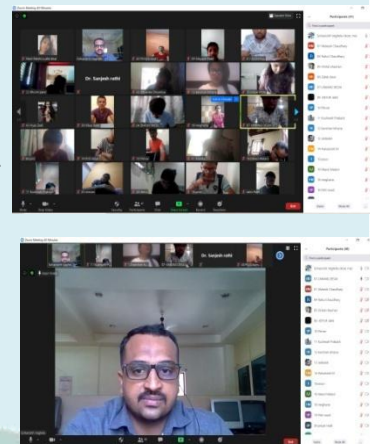

IEC Campaign against COVID-19

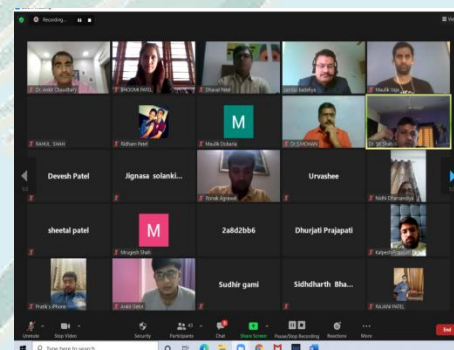
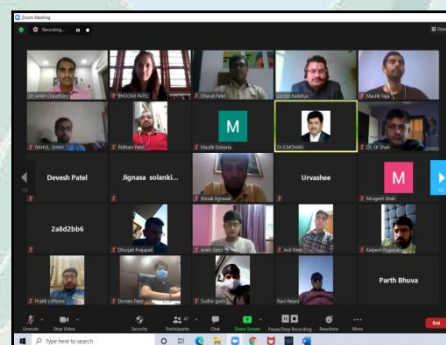
