“Pharmacy Business in a Developing World i.e. Nigeria (Case Study)”

Nigeria is a Country with a population of over 200 million people. The most populous Black Country in Africa situated in the western part of Africa bounded by water on the Southern side and landlocked on the northern side by 4 Countries that are Islamic in nature. Nigeria is awash with Oil and Gas but is bedeviled with corruption, lack of infrastructure especially power. Pharmacy Practice in Nigeria is championed by Federal Ministry of Health through the National Agency for Food and Drug Administration and control (NAFDAC) while PSN (Pharmaceutical Society of Nigeria) which is private sector driven plays a complimentary role. API sector of Nigeria is under-developed thereby inhibiting the recent growth of formulation side of the pharmaceutical sector in Nigeria. Power being a basic infringer in the technological development of country inhibits development of this section. Private investment into power by Individual business escalates the cost of production of pharma products making imports to be far cheaper than locally produced pharma products. As it is in production side so also in the other facets. Young graduates of the pharma profession are lured away to greener pastures of US, UK, AUSTRALIA etc. because of higher remuneration as with their Indian counterparts. I have been involved in the Formulation business for more than twenty years and short-term strategic plans are needed which Nigeria has but faithful implementation of this plans is issue. Policy implementation, India being the pharmacy of the whole world wasn't a short-term plan. It involved a long-term plan. Though India lost track by over-dependence on China on APIs and Intermediates but re-directions by your government is a good Step in the right direction. Hoping also that my government will do same.
