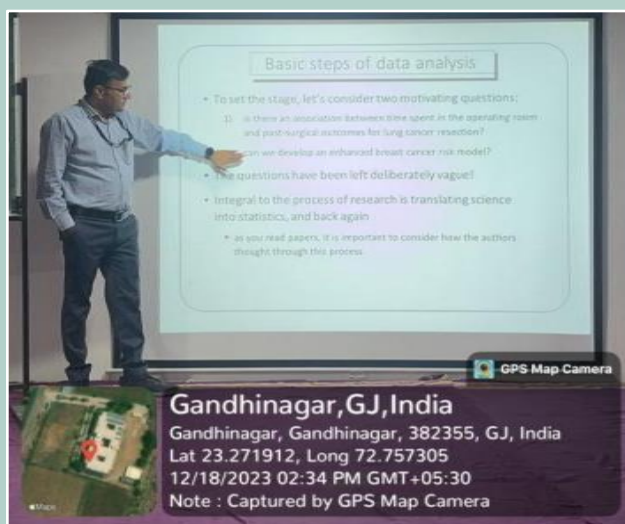
4.4 GUEST LECTURE: APPLICATION OF BIO-STATISTICS IN PHARMACY PRACTICE

The session was informative and useful to our students and research purposes and also in future aspects.

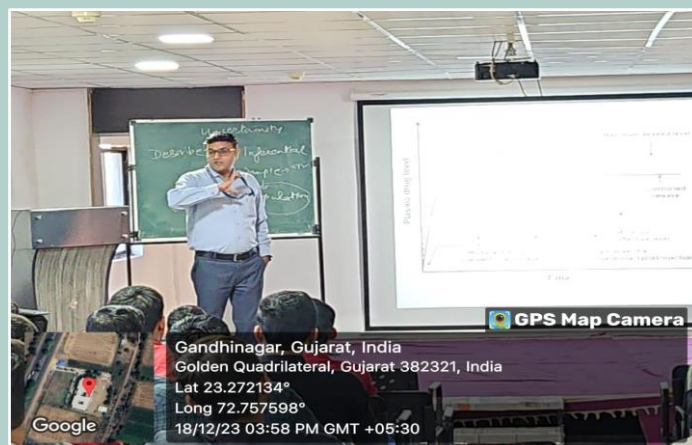


4.5 GUEST LECTURE: BASIC CONCEPT OF PHARMACEUTICAL FORMULATION

Pharmacy is a professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute had arranged industrial visit at Sruzam Labs Pvt. Ltd. on 07th October 2023.

Total 35 students had participated in the industrial visit program from 3rd Sem B.Pharm. During the industrial visit, the representative of the company, Mr. Bhavesh and Mr. Sureshkumar gave detailed and descriptive information about testing of various pharmaceuticals products like tablets, capsules, Ointment. They oriented all major departments involved in physical testing, microbiological testing, preclinical testing, analytical testing, stability testing and IPQC. They correlated the study and actual working at industry and gap between the industry and Academia. During Visit, the students had received extensive information about regulatory and governmental bodies associated for approval and accreditation of testing laboratories such as NABL, CPSCSEA, MHRA etc.

The students were accompanied by faculty Ms. Sneha Dave and Dr. Monvi Sachdev. They guided and explained to them about processing of pharmaceutical products at various stages during plant visits. The students were happy and felt enriched after visiting a plant.

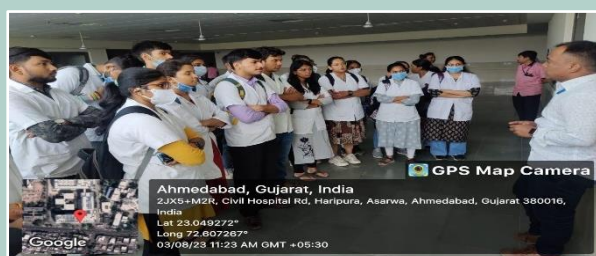

Pharmacy is a professional course where practical knowledge is much more important along with theoretical knowledge. To percolate actual practical exposure, our institute had arranged a hospital visit at The Gujarat Cancer & Research Institute (GCRI) on 26th July 2023 and 3rd August 2023.

A total of 51 students (12, 23 and 16 from 3rd, 4th and 5th Year Pharm D respectively) participated in the visit program. During the Hospital Visit, Mr. Hitesh Bhuriya representative of Hospital had given useful information about different departments like Hematology Lab, Pathology Lab, DNA Screening Cytology, Prosthesis, Pharmacy and Patient Ward. In this visit, the hospital representative had explained useful information about testing on whole blood, serum, urine, cerebrospinal fluids, and other body fluids in Hematology Lab. While in Pathology Lab He explained about the clinical specimens to obtain information about the health of a patient to aid in diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease. He also explained how to diagnose or screen for cancer in **the DNA Screening Cytology department** and about a device designed to replace a missing part of the body or to make a part of the body work better.

The students were accompanied by above mentioned faculties who guided and explained to them the importance of a hospital, pharmacy and patient as per their syllabus at various stages of visit to the hospital. The students were happy and felt enriched after visiting a hospital.

6.9 WORLD HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

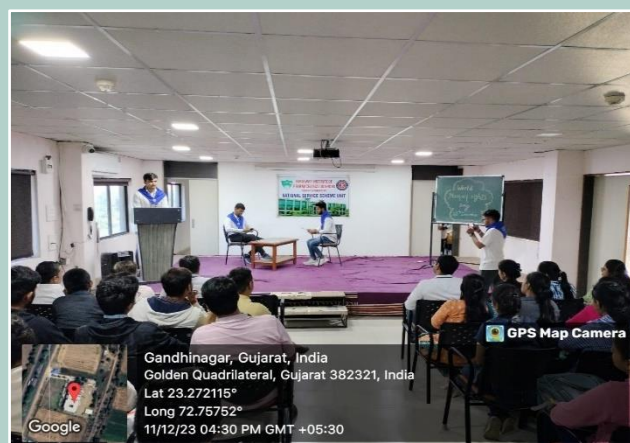
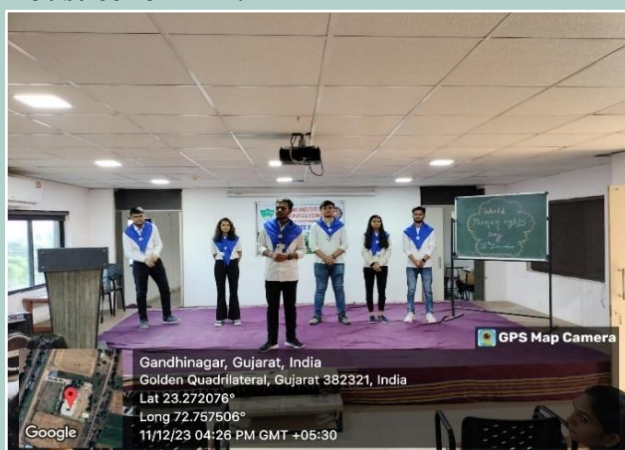

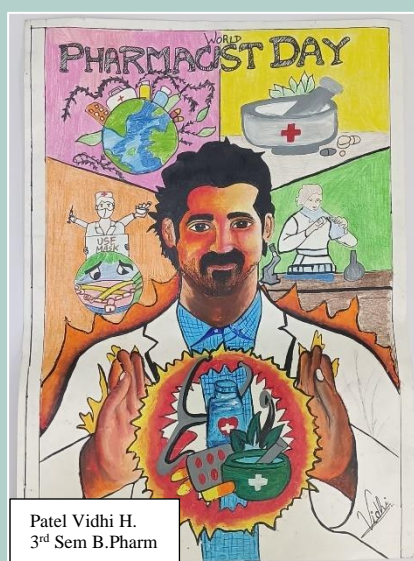
11. SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

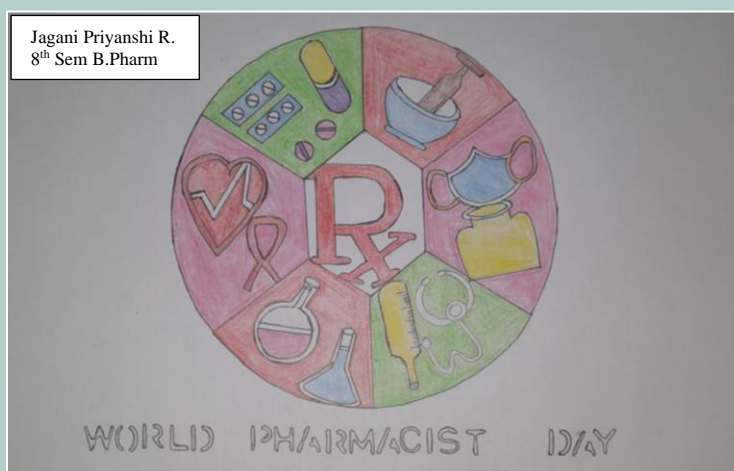
