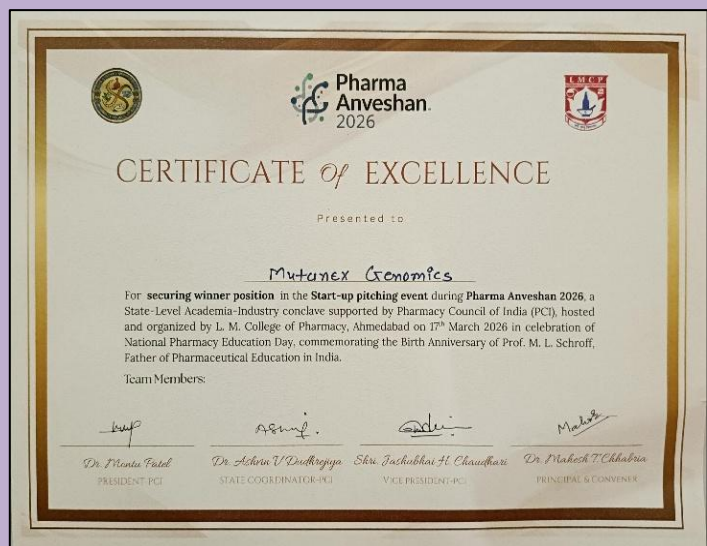

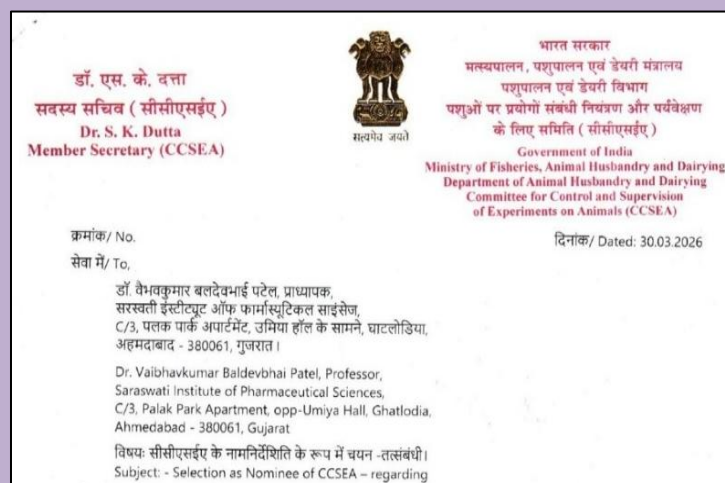

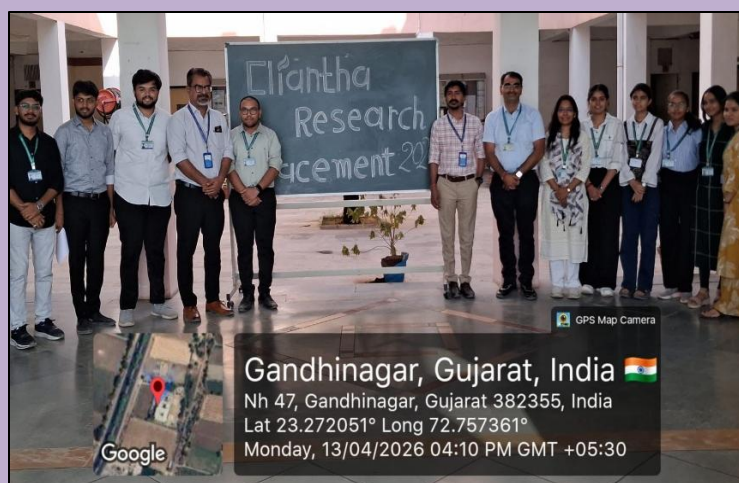

The training provided insights into pharmaceutical regulatory affairs, quality systems, analytical instrumentation, documentation, and global compliance standards. Attendees participated in sessions covering ICH Q1, Q3, Q8, Q9, and Q10 guidelines, Quality Management Systems, 21 CFR Part 211, CTD and eCTD submissions, and impurity profiling, along with hands-on training on HPLC, LCMS, and GCMS. Through a mix of lectures, demonstrations, and discussions, the programme enhanced participants' comprehension of regulatory requirements and quality systems, bolstered industry–academia interaction, and promoted collaboration in education, research, and training. The programme wrapped up with a valedictory session, participant feedback, and the awarding of certificates.
